DO YOU LOVE TO WRITE?

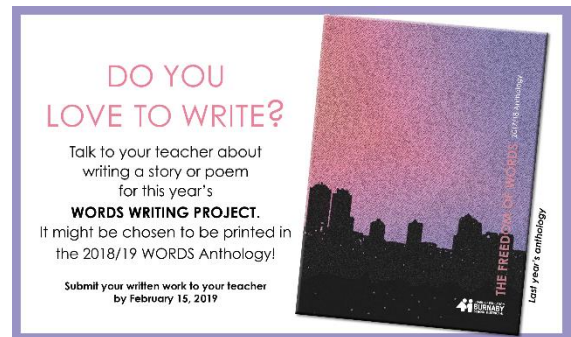
Talk to your teacher about writing a story or poem for this year's Words Writing Project.
