



Career Life Connections 12 Capstone Midterm Interview Requirements

Capstone Presentations are scheduled for Thursday, April 16th, 2020.

***** Capstone Midterm Interviews are scheduled for ***
January 21st and January 22nd, 2020.**

Your major Term Two CLC 12 requirement is participation in a Capstone Midterm Interview with either Ms. Jackson or Ms. Larisch. During this interview, you will be discussing the status of your Capstone Project. This interview and your evidence for it will be assessed.

You will be given an appointment time in advance of the two interview dates (January 21st or January 22nd). You need to arrive in the Career Center 5 minutes before your scheduled time, ready to begin your interview.

In advance of your interview, please ensure that you have completed and submitted to the Career Centre the following things:

- Capstone Proposal
- Mentor Assignment
- Action Log for Term One
- CLC 12 Assignment #2
- CLC 12 Assignment #3

Note: If you have not submitted your **Work Experience** verification paperwork, provide the location and the dates where you will be going to complete your hours. **Your placement must be arranged prior to your Midterm Interview.**

What you need to cover in your Midterm Interview

Part One:

(worth 5 marks)

- i. Introduce yourself **formally** (with a greeting and your full name).
- ii. Identify the **type** of Capstone Presentation you will be presenting.
- iii. Share your **Inquiry Question**.
- iv. Share **why** you chose it (the question) and **how** it relates to your Career-Life journey.

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Part Two:

(worth 15 marks)

- i. Share **five action steps** that you **have already started** during the process of working on your Capstone Project.
- ii. For **each** action step, you must provide **evidence** that the step has been initiated.
- iii. For **each** piece of evidence, you must **briefly explain** what you **have and/or expect to learn** and/or what **essential skills** you **have and/or expect to develop**.

Note: Each action step is worth 3 marks x 5 = 15 marks.

Part Three:

(worth 5 marks)

- i. Identify **one or two key (major) insights** you have discovered during the process of your learning up until the moment of your interview. These may include any of the following:

Note: This part should demonstrate clear **reflection** and **thoughtfulness**

Part Four:

(worth 5 marks)

- i. **Preparation!!!**

You will be assessed on how prepared you are for your interview. Were you organized? Do you know what you are talking about? Are your thoughts well expressed?

How much time do you have for all of the above? **Maximum 10 minutes.**
Be prepared and be succinct!
