Dear Families,

With the school year now upon us, I would like to welcome you and your child back for the 2020-2021 school year. I hope that you and your family are well and had an enjoyable summer.

I am writing to provide you with more information regarding next steps if you selected an option other than returning to full time, in-class instruction.

Option - Home Schooling

- If you haven't already done so, please contact the school to let us know that your child will be home schooled this year.

Options:

At Home Learning for Medical Reasons (for students who are immunocompromised, have an underlying medical condition, or are living with someone who is)

and

Online Distributed Learning

- These program options will be offered during the 2020-21 school year, while in the current pandemic stage ([Stage 2](#)), as set by the Ministry of Education.
- Students will be assigned online learning teachers who will deliver the curriculum and assess student's progress remotely, combining opportunities for scheduled virtual interactions with independent student work and activities.
- Students will be placed in an online classroom with students from throughout the District and may be in a class with students of different grade levels.
- The program will be divided into 10-week quarters with two classes taken each quarter (for a total of eight classes over the year).
- Students will be scheduled into their courses. Some course options may not be available.
- To provide as many course options as possible, Grade 10, 11, and 12 students may need to also enroll in a year-long Burnaby Online course for their elective choice.
 - For example, if a student wishes to take Accounting 11, but we are not able to offer it in this program, they may enroll in Accounting 11 in the regular Burnaby Online program.
- Parents/Guardians will need to support their child's learning. The amount of support will vary depending on your child's age and their ability to work independently.
- Students will need access to a computer.
- Further information regarding this program will be provided directly to you during the week of September 14th. Please do not contact Burnaby Online regarding registration.

In order to maintain a stable learning environment, students will be provided an opportunity to transition back to a school setting at the beginning of each quarter. Please note that some options and courses may not be available at the school at that time, and schedules may need to be adjusted.

We are looking forward to working with you and your child to have a successful and rewarding school year ahead.
